"Christ's Ascension into Glory"

Sermon Text: Acts 1:1-11 (p. 1156); Old Testament Text: Psalm 110:1-7 (p. 646); Gospel Text: Luke 24: 50-53 (p. 1126).

Read Acts 1:1-11 (p. 1156) while listening to the sermon, then answer the questions below.

1. Read Acts 1:1-2 (p. 1156). Who is speaking here?

2. Read Acts 1:3 (p. 1156).Who is the "*he*" referred to in v. 3, and to whom does "*them*" refer?

Over how many days does *he* appear to them?

What did *he* speak to them about?

3. Read Acts 1:4-5 (p. 1156). What did Jesus order them to do in v. 4?

According to v. 5, what would they receive if they obeyed Jesus's commands?

4. Read Acts 1:6-7 (p. 1156).What were the apostles hoping would happen now?

What did they think that would look like?

How did Jesus respond in v. 7?

5. Read Acts 1:8 (p. 1156). What did Jesus promise the apostles they would receive in Jerusalem?

What were they to do with it?

- 6. Read Acts 1:9 (p. 1156). What happened in this verse?
- Read Acts 1:10-11 (p. 1156).Who appeared to the apostles as they were watching Jesus's ascension into heaven?

What very important fact did these visitors make the apostles aware of?

What is the urgent message implied in that reminder, not only for the apostles, but also for us?
