Answering the Call: Our Church Supports Marion Medical Mission

This month, our church's Mission Board voted to support the work of Marion Medical Mission - a ministry dedicated to providing clean, safe drinking water to the most remote villages in surrounding regions of sub-Saharan Africa.

Through generous financial gifts, we are joining hands with a mission that has helped install over 53,000 shallow wells since 1990, giving millions of people access to one of life's most basic needs: clean water.

In February, our congregation gave \$1,820.50 and in April we gave \$452. We have now given enough donations to fund almost 5 wells! Each well only costs \$475 and 100% of donations go towards the designated purpose! We are praying we can give more in the month of June. Please make checks payable to Trinity Lutheran Church and note on check memo or in offering envelope "Mission Fund."

As a church, we are called to serve not only within our walls or neighborhoods but also beyond our borders. By supporting Marion Medical Mission, we're living our Christ's call to "give a cup of cold water in His name" (Matthew 10:42).
